DEFINITION:	
Identifies the patient's physical and mental ability to safely use a car, taxi or public transportation. The prior column should describe the patient's ability <u>14 days prior to the start (or resumption) of care visit</u> . The focus for today's assessment – the "current" column – is on what the patient is <u>able</u> to do today.	
TIME POINTS ITEM(S) COMPLETED:	
Start of care - prior and current ability Resumption of care - prior and current ability Discharge from agency - not to an inpatient facility -- current ability	
RESPONSE—SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "UK - Unknown" is an option only in the "prior" column. This response should be used only if there is no way to determine the patient's prior ability on this item. 	
ASSESSMENT STRATEGIES:	
A combined observation/interview approach with the patient or caregiver is required to determine the most accurate response for this item. Ask the patient about the ability to safely use transportation and the type of assistance required. Utilize observations made during the assessment of ambulation, transferring, and other activities of daily living (ADLs) to assist in determining the best response to this item.
