DEFINITION:
Identifies the type of inpatient facility to which the patient was admitted.
TIME POINTS ITEM(S) COMPLETED:
Transfer to inpatient facility - with or without agency discharge Discharge from agency - not to an inpatient facility
RESPONSE—SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admission to a freestanding rehabilitation hospital or a rehabilitation distinct part unit of a general acute care hospital is considered a rehabilitation facility admission. • Admission to a skilled nursing facility (SNF), an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded (ICF/MR), or a nursing facility (NF) is a nursing home admission.
ASSESSMENT STRATEGIES:
Often the family or medical service provider informs the agency that the patient has been admitted to an inpatient facility. Clarify with this informant as to which type facility the patient has been admitted. As a last resort, you may have to contact the facility to determine how it is licensed.
