<p><b>(M0890)</b> If the patient was admitted to an acute care <b>Hospital</b>, for what <b>Reason</b> was he/she admitted?</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 1 - Hospitalization for <u>emergent</u> (unscheduled) care</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 2 - Hospitalization for <u>urgent</u> (scheduled within 24 hours of admission) care</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 3 - Hospitalization for <u>elective</u> (scheduled more than 24 hours before admission) care</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> UK - Unknown</p>
<b>DEFINITION:</b>
Identifies the urgency of the hospital admission.
<b>TIME POINTS ITEM(S) COMPLETED:</b>
Transfer to inpatient facility - with or without agency discharge
<b>RESPONSE—SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A patient hospitalized immediately subsequent to a doctor's office, outpatient clinic, or ER visit has been hospitalized for emergent care.</li> <li>• A hospitalization that is scheduled is either urgent or elective depending on whether there were more than 24 hours between the scheduling and the actual admission.</li> </ul>
<b>ASSESSMENT STRATEGIES:</b>
Interview the patient, family, or medical service provider to determine whether the acute hospitalization was related to emergent, urgent, or elective care.
